Dear Mr. Scavone:

Congratulations! On behalf of the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA), Center for Veterans Enterprise (CVE), upon review of the Request for Reconsideration received, February 8, 2011, I am writing to inform you that the service-disabled Veteran-owned small business (SDVOSB), Point Breeze Communications, Inc., (PBC) has been verified and added to the verified Veteran business database at www.VetBiz.gov. The business will be eligible to participate in Veterans First Contracting Program opportunities with VA. This verification is valid for up to one year from the date of this letter.

CVE initially denied PBC's verified status by decision dated January 18, 2012. CVE determined that the applicant did not meet the requirements of 38 CFR Part 74 because restrictions were present in the company's Bylaws and because you were not the highest paid employee. With the Request for Reconsideration, the applicant provided an amendment to the Bylaws, which eliminates the restrictions on your ability to transfer interest in the company. Additionally, the applicant provided a signed letter explaining that you have taken a lower salary out of necessity due to recent economic conditions. Based on the foregoing, CVE grants the Request for Reconsideration.


